**Community Services Division**

- Staff is working on a Public Art Plan that will help guide acceptance of public art.
- Staff are working with the IT department to implement volunteer management software and recreation software. These improvements will streamline processes and procedures.

**Kimball Senior Center Report**

- The Kimball Senior Center attendance for the month of April was 2,038.
- The San Diego Food Bank monthly senior commodity distribution program helped 469 senior citizens.
- The Kimball Seniors and Casa Seniors clubs both had Mother's/Father's day catered luncheons. They were well attended with over 100 seniors at each event.

**Tiny Tots Report**

- The Tiny Tots program held their annual Spring Fashion show. The students modeled their favorite outfits, performed skits and had a light lunch.
- Staff are updating registration packets and the process for the next session, which begins in September.

**Camacho Recreation Center Report**

- In April, Camacho Recreation Center had 1,332 participants.
- We have a new Yoga class that began in April with yoga instructor Kevin Atkinson. The class takes place on Fridays at 5:30 - 6:45 p.m. and Saturdays at 11:30 - 12:15 p.m. and is free and open to the public.

**Casa de Salud Youth Center Report**

- Staff are coordinating a field trip to a Padres Game on May 15 for youth and parents.
- Staff will be rolling out a new registration packet and procedure in May.
- Staff are beginning to purchase new equipment to enhance the safety of the facility and provide additional programs.

**National City Aquatic Center Report**

- Staff have begun advertising youth rowing and sailing camps for June through August.
