**Kimball Senior Center Report**

- The Kimball Senior Center attendance for the month of September was 2,013 and in October attendance was 2,248.
- The San Diego Food Bank monthly senior commodity distribution program helped 200 senior citizens.
- Both senior clubs are preparing for their annual Holiday Luncheons.

**Tiny Tots Report**

- The El Toyon Recreation Center parking lot is now housing a National City Fire Department sub-station. The parking is shared by the sub-station and the recreation center. There are now 18 parking spaces that include 2 handicap spaces.
- The Tiny Tots classes came together for a Halloween party on October 30, 2017 with treats and games for the kids.

**Las Palmas Municipal Pool Report**

- Lap and open swim programs and aquatic exercise classes continue to do well.
- The National School District is still holding 3<sup>rd</sup> grade learn to swim classes.

**Camacho Recreation Center Report**

- The fitness room at Camacho Recreation Center is complete and being used by adults in the community.

**Casa de Salud Youth Center Report**
