The City of National City in partnership with CSA San Diego County, National City's fair housing service provider, want to spread awareness about fair housing rights and resources. We are committed to making National City a place for everyone to live.

On April 11, 1968, the Fair Housing Act was signed into law.

Definition: Fair housing describes a condition in which individuals of similar income levels in the same housing market have a like range of choices available to them regardless of a protected class status; prohibits discrimination in housing choice because of protected class status

Federal Protected Classes: religion, disability mental or physical, race/color, ancestry/national origin, sex/gender, and familiar status

California law protected classes: age, marital status, genetic information, sexual orientation, sexual identification/gender expression, AIDS/HIV, medical condition, political activities and affiliation, military or veteran status, and domestic violence survivors.

Green represents harmony, balance, love, and good moral standing. White represents equality, fairness, protection, and understanding.
