**Kimball Senior Center Report**

- The Kimball Senior Center attendance was 1,794 during the month of May.
- The San Diego Food Bank monthly senior commodity distribution program helped 250 seniors in the month of May.
- Both clubs held catered luncheons honoring Mothers and Fathers during the month of May. Kimball had 120 people in attendance and Casa had 100 people in attendance.

**Camacho Recreation Center**

- During the month of May Volleyball open gym had 243 participants and basketball open gym had 1,128 participants.
- Summer classes began on May 28 and staff continue to promote the amazing programs through the City Guide.

**Las Palmas Pool Report**

- The cooler weather in May deterred a lot of people from coming to the pool consistently. June swim lesson enrollments or less than normal as many people are waiting for warmer weather.
- For the second year, staff held swim lessons for the 4<sup>th</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> grade special education classes from Lincoln Acres. These lessons work in conjunction with a swim safety grant that the school received through the San Diego Junior Lifeguard Foundation. Many of these kids have little to no exposure to swimming and over the course of their lessons the majority were much more comfortable in the water.
- South Coast Water Polo and Southern Water Polo continued to use the facility for their team practices.

**Manuel Portillo Casa de Salud Youth Center**

- For the month of May, Casa de Salud had a total of 346 participants.
- In April, programming included a special mother's day craft, video games, dodgeball, foosball, and air hockey tournaments.
- The youth club hosted trivia night and Fun Friday where they voted on a movie to watch as a group.
- The Casa de Salud youth center will be teaming up with Feeding San Diego to provide free lunches over the summer break.

**Parks Division Report**

- Work completed in May 2019: weeds sprayed at parks and outer areas, ballfield maintenance, removal of homeless camps, irrigation repairs and fertilizing parks, 96 trees trimmed, 11 trees removed and 10 trees stumped.

**Special Events**

- The Intergenerational Plant Workshop is part of our new intergenerational quarterly series. Manuel Portillo Casa de Salud hosted a fun day of learning & planting on Saturday, May 18.
