Kimball Senior Center

- The Kimball Senior Center attendance was 2,568 for the month of October.
- The San Diego Food Bank October monthly senior commodity distribution program helped 492 seniors.
- The Kimball Seniors Club held two Halloween dances with Costume Contests.
- The County of San Diego in collaboration with the City of National City held a free Flu Shot Clinic on Tuesday, October 15th.

Camacho Center

- The Camacho gymnasium offers a variety of open sports such as, soccer, basketball, and volleyball and during the month of August, gym attendance was about 1,114.
- Fall season is now over, 19 successful programs were offered by City staff and contract instructors.
- The City Guide was released on Monday, November 4, 2019. Winter Registration is now open and the ten week winter season starts on Monday, November 25.

Manuel Portillo Casa de Salud Youth Center

- Attendance at Casa de Salud for the month of October had a total of 343 participants.
- In October staff provided Halloween themed arts and crafts, sports activities, and video games.
- Our staff also hosted a Fall Festival where youth were encouraged to dress up in their costume and decorate pumpkins. We had special guest judges from PD and Camacho Recreation Center pick the top 3 costumes and top 6 pumpkins. Those chosen by the judges won 2 movie tickets. Youth also enjoyed festival games, pizza, wings and pumpkin pie!



Special Events

- The Community Services Department assisted with the Inaugural Dia De Los Muertos event hosted by the Mayor's office. Staff hosted the arts and crafts booth and made tissue marigolds with attendees.

Public Works

- Scheduled work in City parks for October were playground repairs, drain installation,

Las Palmas Park paver installation, and work on the medians.

- The tree crew trimmed 128 trees, removed 15 trees and stumped 10 trees.
