## FACE COVERINGS ARE NOW MANDATORY FOR EVERYONE IN NATIONAL CITY

The National City City Council voted unanimously on Tuesday to enact an emergency order to require the National City community to wear face coverings anytime they leave their home and are in public settings.

The emergency ordinance will be effective at midnight 12:00am on April 22, 2020.
