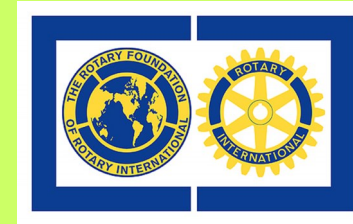

Did you know that you cannot be denied a repair because of your religion, sex, gender, orientation, etc. ?

Did you know that your unit must be free of any vermin, disease causing bugs, or infestations?

Did you know that mold in your unit is considered uninhabitable and can cause major health illnesses ?

Did you know necessary repairs must be done equally to all units? One group cannot benefit more than another

Did you know that smoke alarms must be update to a 10 year life model by July 2014 and in come cases July 2015?
