Property Owner:

On May 15, 2018, the City Council of the City of National City directed staff to contact the owners of potentially historic properties to be considered for designation and listing on the City's local historic properties list. Your property was identified in a survey as one of those with potential historic significance. Consequently, we are notifying you that your property may be included as one of those that the City Council may consider for designation and listing.

There would be no cost to you for your property to be included for consideration since this is an initiative of the City Council. The usual application fee of up to \$5,050 would not apply. In addition, you may become eligible for potential property tax savings through the Mills Act Program if your property is designated and listed.
