The money raised will be used to purchase sealed teddy bears but more importantly bedtime carts and bereavement boxes. Bedtime carts make nightly rounds at Rady Children's Hospital and contain items of comfort for patients and their families. Bereavement boxes are a personal creative and therapeutic way for a terminally-ill child to compile customized mementoes for their family to cherish over time, after their loss.
