

Action Item III- Consideration and discussion to request hybrid (in person/virtual) public meetings for City boards, commissions and committees

The City will be returning to in-person public meetings beginning August 1, 2021. Please plan to attend your Board/Commission/Committee meetings in person at City Hall or location of meeting as agendized. Below are the current Health Orders and Guidelines being followed and we ask that you read the information below to ensure you understand the requirements.

Revised Health Orders

The California Department of Public Health also released a [new public health order](#) in effect replaces the previous public health orders, as well as [new face coverings guidance](#) to match the CDC's guidance, lifting California's mask requirements for vaccinated individuals.

In summary, restaurants, shopping malls, movie theaters, and most everyday places will be open as normal with no capacity limits or social distancing requirements, including local government facilities. There are a few exceptions such as indoor events of 5,000 people or more, and for outdoor events of 10,000 people or more that will have additional requirements in place.

Masks Guidelines at City Facilities for Public

The California Department of Public Health will no longer require vaccinated individuals to wear masks in public. It will now be optional. Unvaccinated individuals will still be asked to wear masks. This includes all City facilities, unless the County of SD and/or State have put additional regulations in place that apply to a specific facility. We are not allowed to ask members of the public whether or not they are vaccinated so enforcement will be on the honor system.
