

Action Item IV- Consideration and discussion of establishing a relationship with Sweetwater High School Marines Corps JROTC program.

The Marine Corps Junior ROTC Program was established at Sweetwater High School in 1995. SUHI possesses the only Marine Corps JROTC Program in the Sweetwater High School District.

MISSION: Our mission is to develop courageous, character driven young adults who possess the attributes of personal responsibility and accountability in order to become model citizens in service to the United States.

Below you'll see information from Sweetwater High School's data set on graduation seniors plans after graduation. There were 43 individuals from the graduating class of 2020 that self-reported of their plans to enter into the military. This data can be used by the Committee to determine opportunities for assistance and support, including those within the JRROTC program.

National City created a data dashboard to help connect residents with the resources they need to advance or change careers. We have collected over 40 different data sets and worked with half a dozen partners across the region to identify new opportunities to reach our residents, identify gaps in the workforce and highlight careers in priority job sectors that pay above the median average in San Diego County and don't require a 4yr degree.
